



Use **PowerLift** whenever you have to lift things like these short pieces of rebar. Stand in a <u>wide stance</u> as close to the load as you can. <u>Bridge to your leg</u> with your free hand while you reach for the rebar with your opposite hand and make sure to <u>bend your knees</u> and not your back.

Notice how this worker has <u>stepped over the rebar</u> on the ground so that he stays close to the load before he lifts it up to his shoulder. This is easy to do if you keep your wide stance.

Then, <u>stay in a wide stance</u> as you lift the rebar up to your shoulder to carry it away. This is using **PowerLift** and will help you to keep from injuring and wearing out your back during your working years.
