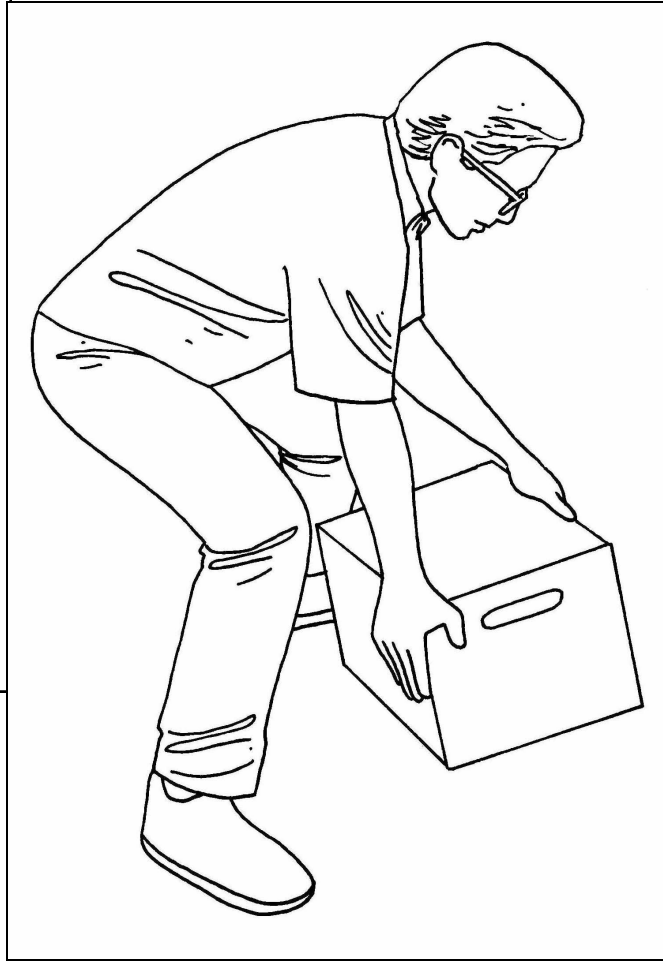
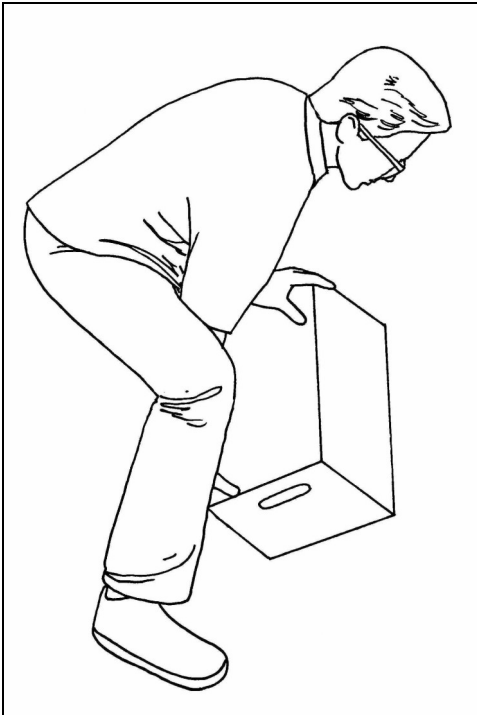


TROUBLE SHOOTING GUIDE



TIPPING THE LOAD UP ONTO THE CORNER INSTEAD OF ITS EDGE

Students will have a tendency to tip the load up onto its corner instead of onto its edge, which makes the load unstable and harder to hold. This is usually because they are grasping the front of the load at the corner as they prepare to tip it. Instead, have them grasp the front of the load at the center which will automatically cause it to tip onto its edge. This will make the load much more stable and easier to handle as the hands are positioned to lift it.
