

SAMPLING FROM A MOVING CONVEYOR

Collecting a sample from a moving conveyor is a <u>one-handed lift and because of</u> that, should be done with a bridge. In the case above, this lifter can also <u>put his</u> foot up to make the job easier. The bridge can be done to his thigh or to the frame of the conveyor, whichever is more convenient. The point is, the <u>bridge</u> lets his upper body strength help out with the lift. The leg up helps to form a <u>strut which helps to hold his upper body weight</u>, which is important because the task calls for him to reach way out in front to take the sample.
